Step 5: Submitting Urban Garden SAP, Licensure Agreement, Proof of Insurance

Requirements for Adoption Finalized: July 13,2018

By July 13, 2018 AgLanta Grows-A-Lot Adopters must submit:

- 1. " **Urban Garden SAP**": (Site Plan + Management Plan): plans must adhere to approved urban agriculture uses for that site; CoA Urban Agriculture Ordinance; and CoA Bee City Resolution. (*AgLanta Team can assist at 6/30 AgLanta Academy.)
- 2. Five-year "Licensure Agreement" between the Garden Sponsor Organization and City of Atlanta.
- 3. "Certificate of General Liability Insurance" in the amount of no less than \$1 million with the City of Atlanta listed as an additionally insured party. (* Groundwork Atlanta can cover your insurance at no cost to your urban garden!)

The following application administration and license fees will be paid at the time the license agreement is finalized:

Five-year license administrative fee and annual license fee for 5-year adoption. (waived/\$1).

Water meter at site/back flow (\$0.00 paid for by OoR)

Insurance (\$0.00 - paid by Groundwork Atlanta)

Urban Agriculture SAP (\$30.00/year).

Provide a check payable to:

"City of Atlanta" in the form of cash, credit card, personal/cashier check, or money order.



Step 5: Submitting **Urban Garden SAP**, **Licensure Agreement**, **Proof of Insurance, Bank Account, and Organizational**Structure

Requirements for Adoption Finalized: July 13, 018

By July 13, 2018 AgLanta Grows-A-Lot Adopters must submit:

- "Urban Garden SAP": (Site Plan + Management Plan): plans must adhere to approved urban agriculture uses for that site; CoA Urban Agriculture Ordinance; and CoA Bee City Resolution.
- Five-year "Licensure Agreement" between the farmer, Groundwork Atlanta, CoA, and Georgia Power.
- "Certificate of General Liability Insurance" in the amount of no less than \$1 million with the City of Atlanta listed as an additionally insured party. Please see the link to shared urban agriculture insurance policies on the resource page.
- · Proof of a farm bank account.
- Proof of an **organizational structure** for the farm (ex: non-profit, LLC, etc.)

Water meter/back flow: (\$0.00 paid for by OoR).






AGLANTA Urban Garden Site Plans (2:50-3:00 PM)

Site plan: map or design of your urban garden.

A site plan is: 1) part of the SAP package; 2) a picture of your team's unified vision; 3) a tool that can be used to assign garden plots, crop plan, common areas (shared infrastructure), Georgia Power, work day assignments, make friends with neighbors who are not gardening, apply for funding, create a phasing plan... etc.
